

Cookies policy

Opendatasoft uses cookies on its website.

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a piece of information, usually small in size and identified by a name, that can be sent to your browser by a website to which you connect. Your web browser stores it for a period of time and sends it back to the web server each time you connect. Cookies have many uses: they can be used to store your customer ID at a merchant's site, the current contents of your shopping basket, an identifier that can be used to track your browsing for statistical or advertising purposes, etc.

Opendatasoft uses different types of cookies:

Strictly necessary cookies: These cookies are necessary to ensure access and optimal use of the services provided. These cookies are placed automatically on your browser.

Supplier name	Cookie name	Duration	Function
Opendatasoft	sessionid	2 weeks by default	Authentication: validates the user's identity for each request.
Opendatasoft	csrftoken	Token randomly reset between two requests or two sessions. Up to 12 months	Security: protects against CSRF attacks by generating a unique token for each request or session.
Opendatasoft	cookies_preferences	6 months	Cookie preferences: saves the user's choices regarding the use of cookies.
Opendatasoft	django_language	12 months	Language: remembers the user's selected language for navigation. This cookie is activated only if the portal is available in multiple languages.

How do I configure cookies on my browser?

You can configure your choices through our cookie management center at the bottom of the page.

You can also change your browser settings. Each browser has a different configuration for managing cookies and your choices. This is described in your browser's Help menu (Options or Preferences), which will tell you how to change your preferences regarding cookies.
